# **Interseeding Red Clover in Winter Wheat**

This professional Development workshop will offer an in-depth look at the practice of interseeding a red clover cover crop in winter wheat examining specific production practices and management, nitrogen credits and crediting for corn, impact on conservation compliance using SNAPplus and economics. It will feature a combination of classroom and field presentations including the 2017 cover crop and corn following last year's cover crop at a local farm, drawing on 20-years' experience and research data on the practice. Three (3) CEUs in crop management are available and materials include a binder containing the most up to date cover crop references.

These professional development opportunities are a joint effort of the Michael Fields Agricultural Institute, UW-Extension and the North Central SARE Professional Development Program. They are designed for professionals who advise farmers and will provide an opportunity for in-depth discussion of cover crop management.
